19. CASA DO SOL 'FROINA' ALBARINO

Rias Baixas, Spain Lemony citrus and pine aromas are interesting. Fresh, nuanced, complex Albarino made in tiny quantities, more remeniscent of the wines of Chablis than Galicia.

31. CHATEAU D`ISSAN, MARGAUX Bordeaux, France

Château d'Issan is a Third Growth of the 1855 Imperial Classification. The wine is made from the old vines in the Château d'Issan enclosure in the middle of the Margaux appellation.

The soil there is mainly made up of surface gravel on top of a clay subsoil, which contributes to optimal ripeness and freshness in there two grape varieties, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.

Château d'Issan expresses the exquisite bouquet so characteristic of Margaux, and stands out with it's suppleness, subtlety, elegance and long keeping potential that come from its unique terroir.

Château d'Issan is aged in barrels for 16 to 18 months, half of which are new. Annual production is around 100,000 bottles.

32. ARMAND DE BRIGNAC Champagne, France

In the 1950s, Nelly Cattier, mother to Jean-Jacques, discovered a character in a novel she was reading, called 'M. De Brignac'. She found the name noble and registered it for use on a new wine in the future. It was long forgotten, and during the creation of this new tête de cuvée from the house in the early 2000s, Jean-Jacques decided to pay tribute to his mother by adopting this special name.

Each bottle of Armand de Brignac is coated in metal, finished with the hand application of French pewter labels and polished. Only 20 bottles can be completed per person per hour in the winery, and as a result, no two bottles are the same.

To taste, peach, apricot and red berry aromas, followed by crystalized citrus, orange blossom and hints of brioche. Rich palate of cherries, exotic fruits, lemon, vanilla and honey. The mouth is soft and creamy, with a hint of toastiness, from the unique dosage aged for one year in French oak.
